
How to Procure through Frameworx

DIRECT AWARDS

Contracts called off by Direct Award must be awarded in accordance with "objective criteria", which this *simplified flow chart can help you with. (*refer to the full flow chart in the Frameworx brochure.)



Still looking?

- estimate the volume, mix and location of Works and/or Services that Client requires under the Call-off Contract;
- · apply each Framework Provider's tendered Prices to those Works and/or Services; and
- · using the original "non-price" scores (from setting up the Framework) and the prices for the specific Works and/or Services required, rank each Framework Provider's tenders in terms of economic advantage.



NB: NPC will provide support and guidance to Clients on this Direct Award process. It is important that Clients follow this process exactly, otherwise their call-off may be open to challenge.



MINI COMPETITION

- Establish interest from the Approved Providers on that framework.
- Prepare and issue an Invitation to submit a Mini-Tender (IMT), which needs to include the client's requirements for the Call-off Contract, the award criteria (price and quality) and time plan for evaluation and award.
- Evaluation criteria should be based on that of the original framework (40 Price: 56 Quality: 4 Social value).
- · Price to be based on the rates and prices that formed the basis of the framework.
- Standstill procedures apply, with feedback to be provided.
